The Catholic World
Community welcomes the new
Pope, Pope Francis from
Argentina. Pope Francis was
born on 17 December 1936 in
Buenos Aires, Argentina, and
ordained Priest on 13
December 1969. As a Jesuit
he completed post graduate
studies in Germany and is
fluent in Spanish, Italian and
German. He was ordained
Bishop in 1992 for the city of
Buenos Aires where he served
as an Auxiliary Bishop until
1998 when he became
Archbishop. He was made a
Cardinal by Pope John Paul II
in 2001, and elected Pope on
March 14th, 2013. He leads the
Church in difficult times, but

as a man of great faith he will
not resile from the challenges
that confront us. Let us keep
him in our thoughts and

For early readers:

**PLEASE SAY "I spy with my little eye
something beginning
with the sound b" (as in Boab)
NOT "I spy with my little eye something
beginning with the letter B" (as in bee)**

**It is vital for early reading development
that children are able to hear the
actual sound made/heard-not just
become familiar with the name of the
letter which represents that sound!**
