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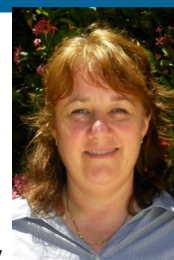

## From the Principal - Ms Naomi



Welcome to the last week of Term One.

I would like to congratulate families and students on their endurance for the term. It has been a long term, and our attendance has been good. There are several students who have 100% attendance across all years—for these students and families you are to be commended.

This is a timely reminder to Parents that Pre-Primary is now a compulsory year of education, and therefore, it is the law that students of Pre-Primary age and above are required to attend school every day. Apart from the legal requirements, the students have a much better chance of reaching their potential if they come to school each day.

### LEARNING JOURNALS

Learning Journals will be sent home in the next few days. The young students' Learning Journals need to be collected by a parent. Please come in this afternoon or in the next few days and collect the Learning Journal from the teachers. I ask all parents to take the time to sit with your child and discuss the Journal. Research shows that students have a greater chance of excellent success if the parents are working with teaching staff to support their education.

### STORYTIME

Storytime begins the first week of Term 2. Storytime will be held in the library on Monday's from 10.30am—12noon on school days. The session be led by Ms Shirley and consist of a story, an

activity and some time for parent and child to look at other books in the Library. It is for all parents with children from 0—4 yrs of age in the Wyndham community. **LIBRARY BOOK BORROWING** As of term 2, all students are encouraged to take a book home from our school Library. Ms Maureen has set up the system so that students can borrow a book for a week. This is to encourage home reading, and to help the students develop interests. Students must use a book bag—which will be supplied by the school. I ask parents to help the students be responsible for the books, take care of them and bring them back to school in the same state in which they took them home. It is an opportunity for parents to read with and read to their children.

### ASSEMBLIES

From term 2 our assemblies will begin to take a fresh format. The assemblies will alternate between a general assembly and a class assembly. Every second week a class will present a performance, or some information about what has been happening in the classroom. I ask parents to support their children, and make the time to come in to assemblies. The first class assembly is the Year 3,4,5 class on Friday 17th May at 12.15pm. Please check the newsletter each week for the upcoming assemblies.

### CHRISTIAN COUNCIL

On Wednesday 17th April I will take the Christian Council to visit Marigu Village. I hope to begin a good association with Marigu Village and the old people. Our

students can learn a lot from the old people, and the aged can have a happy day talking with the young.

### SPORTS

On Thursday (18th April) this week the senior students (Yr 567 boys and Yr 67 girls) are involved in the local sports carnival. The students have been training with WDHS for the last couple of weeks. We with them well, and hope they enjoy the day of sports with good team spirit.
