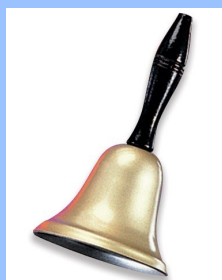
MOTHERS DAY

If you are wanting to have free guitar lessons and join our club, see Mr Danny during school hours.

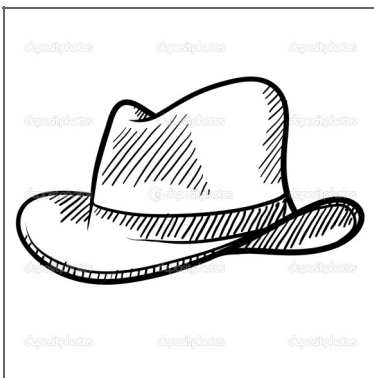

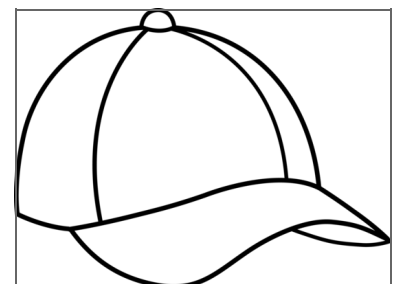
